



### Faith, Hope, and Love

These three combined theological virtues help us to live our best Christian life.

**Faith** is the instrument or means or the way God uses to save His people. It is a precious gift of God which enables people to believe in Christ as the only hope for their salvation and to trust in what He did on the cross is for them and to keep trusting in Christ.

**Hope** then causes believers in Christ to eagerly look forward to Christ's promises being fulfilled. If faith make the believers certain that Christ's promises will be fulfilled, hope fills them with eager anticipation.

Faith and hope are very personal. **Love** enables believers in Jesus to reach out beyond themselves and their needs and be concerned about others. I Corinthians 13 reminds us that love is patient, kind, does not envy, does not boast, is not proud, is not rude or self-seeking, is not easily angered, keeps no records of wrongs, does not delight in evil but rejoices in the truth. Love never fails. No wonder in I Cor. 13:13 we read that the greatest of these three is love.

Love is not the Hollywood type that we see on the screen, it is a deep selfless consideration for others. It is the deep desire that everyone knows the saving grace of Jesus. In recent years we see less and less of that true love of God in the world. It seems that worldly pleasures and selfish desires are taking precedence.

We, as Christians, often complain about all the senseless acts of violence and feel that something should be done about it. Unfortunately, we often think the answer is with someone else, we don't consider what we should or can do. We may not be able to stop mob violence, but we can be a living example of Jesus and witness to those at work, play, shopping, etc. There is an old hymn we used to sing that tells us to 'win them one by one'. If each one can influence another to love the Lord, we can change our country.
