Kyle Taylor, Director, Center for American Indians, at Bacone College, will speak at the Clergy & Spouse Gathering hosted by the Region Ministers Council on Thursday, Oct. 11, at Cross Wind.

Prior to his current position, Kyle served as the Director of Learning Work for the Center for American Indians, and Director of Native American Programs at Bacone. He has also served in American Indian Recruitment at the University of Oklahoma in High School and College Relations, and the Educational Opportunity Program at San Francisco State University.

Kyle attended the University of Oklahoma before serving the American Indian community for 20 years in Christian leadership development. He holds a Master's Degree in Leadership and will complete his doctorate in Organizational Leadership Development this year.
