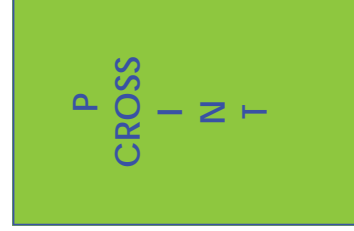

Prayer Partners Program

Church camp is often a highlight of a young person's spiritual experience. Many make first time decisions to follow Christ. Others feel the call into full-time Christian service.

As a way of mentoring and encouraging our young people, the Region has a program that connects a spiritually mature adult with each youth in the church. The best way to start this connection is by committing an adult who is not a family member or the pastor to pray for a child going to camp. The Prayer Partner agrees to pray daily for the camper and to send one note or card to him/her while at camp. Each Prayer Partner should also visit with their camper following camp week to share experiences and decisions that might have been made.

Having a loving, supportive church and a caring Prayer Partner encourages the spiritual growth of our youth.

Make sure each one has a Prayer Partner; and list the Prayer Partner name on the registration form.
