- College graduate preferred, with some emphasis in worship arts, music or performing arts
- Have a passion for working with youth
- Have a passion for leading praise and worship

Duties:

- Lead weekly worship practice
- Assist in creating an environment of worship that goes beyond singing and music
- Work together with the ministerial staff to lead the congregation into an authentic encounter with God in worship
- Select music that reinforce the sermon text and theme of the weekly worship service
- Design special elements for worship including things such as liturgical dance, visual arts or drama
- Work with youth, ministerial staff, and parents to plan youth activities and outreach
- General activities include: fun/fellowship, prayer, Bible study, education/discussion, and service
- Foster an environment in which youth are encouraged to be themselves, are respectful of each other, and are excited to be together
- Encourage youth to attend church activities
- Integrate youth ministry into all phases of church life
- Stay current with worship art and youth ministry practices
- Communicate with ministerial staff, youth and their parents via email, telephone and mailing
- Build relationships with students by spending time with them outside of scheduled group time
